
Time to act!

Summer 2012:



If not stopped immediately, tourism on the coast will break down in a few years.

The problem:

Gulets, daily trip boats and yachts dump tons of there sewage into the creeks.

All dish soaps, shower gels and shampoos contain surfactants, water softeners, bleaches, alkaline materials, optical brighteners, fillers, foam regulators, enzymes, corrosion inhibitors and fragran-

ces that degrade only after tens of years.

No solution:

The Turkish authorities try to get the problem under control with grewater tanks and aspiration systems.

The result:

- No place for additional tanks in the yacht

- Crowds and chaos at the extraction units

- Further secret

"dumping"



The blue card system of the authorities taken further ahead by a market-based approch.

The basic idea:

Not what comes out from the tank is important, but what goes into the tank!

Desirable:

A <u>new</u> product is necessary that breaks down in the sea by 99% in a few days rather than in tens of years.

In this case the secret pumping is no longer a

problem.

Despite other products...

... there is no single environmentally friendly detergent!

All contain chemical surfactants, which harmful mircoorganisms in the water and dissolve in

nature very slowly.

1. dissolve in sea water within 28 days

2. contains no chemical surfactants, no water softener etc. and no fragrances that leave residues in the sea and
